Subject: Miscellaneous Classification Plan Changes

Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Secretary of the Department of Employment Relations (DER) has approved the classification plan changes identified on this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is October 6, 2002**, unless otherwise stated.

1. *Abolish* the **County Forest Administrator** classification specification **effective October 6, 2002**, because the classification is no longer used by the Department of Natural Resources. No manual reallocations will need to be processed to implement this classification action. Questions may be directed to Wil Mickelson at (608) 266-0714.
2. *Create* the **Community Services Advocate** classification **effective October 6, 2002**, to describe a position located within the Department of Agriculture, Trade, and Consumer Protection. The agency will process a manual reallocation to implement this classification action. Questions may be directed to Wil Mickelson at (608) 266-0714.
3. *Create* the **Hemodialysis Technician** classification **effective September 8, 2002**, to identify positions located at the Department of Corrections that perform dialysis treatment functions for patients. The agency will process manual reallocations to implement this classification action. Questions may be directed to Brian Fusie at (608) 266-1418.
4. *Create* the **Program Support Supervisor-DOC** classification **effective October 6, 2002**, to describe positions located exclusively within the Department of Corrections that were previously classified as Program Assistant Supervisor and Program Assistant Supervisor-Advanced. These supervisory positions require a significant amount of knowledge of correctional operations. The agency will process manual reallocations to implement these classification actions and has been delegated authority to implement the new classifications. 5. *Modify* the **Horticultural Technician** classification specification **effective September 8, 2002**, for the University of Wisconsin-Madison to identify a new allocation. The University of Wisconsin will process manual reallocations to implement this classification action. Questions may be directed to Brian Fusie at (608) 266-1418.
6. *Modify* the **Human Resources Specialist-Advanced** classification specification **effective October 6, 2002**, to create a new allocation for a compensation coordinator. No reallocations are required. Questions may be directed to Judy Burke at (608) 267-5166.
7. *Modify* the **Natural Resources Program Supervisor** and the **Natural Resources Program Manager** classification specifications **effective October 6, 2002**, in order to update the representative positions and clarify the allocation language. 8. *Modify* the **Revenue Supervisor** classification specifications **effective October 6, 2002**, to add allocations for supervisors in the Processing Bureau and Audit Bureau within the Department of Revenue.
