Classification Plan Changes

Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the classification plan changes identified on this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is May 30, 2004**, unless otherwise stated.

1. *Abolish* the **Medigap Insurance Specialist – Entry and Objective** classifications; *and create* the **Medigap Insurance Specialist (A) and (B)** classification, **effective May 30, 2004**, to accommodate the pay structure within the WSEU-PSS 2003-2005 contract. The agency will process manual reallocations to implement these classification actions. Questions may be directed to Kris Chilsen at (608) 266-7569.
2. *Abolish* the **Psychologist, Psychologist Doctorate, Psychologist-Senior and Psychologist-Senior Doctorate** classifications; *and create* the **Psychological Associate (A) and (B) and Psychologist-Licensed** classifications, **effective May 30, 2004**, to comply with statutory requirements mandated by the Psychology Examining Board in the Department of Regulation and Licensing and to accommodate the pay structure within the WSEU-PSS 2003-2005 contract. Agencies will process manual reallocations to implement these classification actions. Questions may be directed to Kris Chilsen at (608) 266-7569.
3. *Abolish* the **Chief Regional Psychologist-Doctorate, School Psychologist-Doctorate, and School Psychologist Senior-Doctorate** classifications, **effective May 30, 2004**, *and modify* the **Chief Regional Psychologist, and School Psychologist** classification specifications to remove the “Doctorate” allocations. This is being done in order to coincide with the add-on language in Article 12/7/1 of the WSEU-PSS 2003-2005 contract. Agencies will process manual reallocations to implement this classification action. Questions may be directed to Kris Chilsen at (608) 266-7569.
4. *Modify* the **Medigap Insurance Specialist-Lead** classification specification, **effective May 30, 2004**, to separate this classification from the Medigap Insurance Specialist (A) and (B) classifications identified in item 1 above that are now in a pay progression.
