Subject: Miscellaneous Classification Plan Changes

Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the classification plan changes identified on this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is April 2, 2006**, unless otherwise stated.

- 1) ***Abolish*** the classifications of **Coordinator, Local History; DOA Administrative Coordinator; Local History Specialist; Food Safety Consultant; Military Funeral Honors Program Specialist; Program Schedule Coordinator; Revisor of Statutes; Tool Crib Coordinator; UWM Recruitment Coordinator, and Veterans Employment and Training Specialist, effective April 2, 2006**, in an effort to simplify the classification system. These classifications are vacant at various departments and are not anticipated to be used in the future. Questions may be directed to Lean White at (608) 267-0344.
- 2) ***Abolish*** the classifications of **Building Inspector–Entry; Job Service Associate 1; Natural Resources Customer Services Representative–Entry/Objective; Specification Writer, Specification Writer–Advanced and Senior; Unemployment Benefit Analyst 1 & 2; and Unemployment Benefit Specialist 5** because these titles are vacant and are not likely to be used in the future. ***Modify*** the classification specifications, **effective April 2, 2006**, to remove the language pertaining to the abolished titles in that series. No reallocation notices are necessary for these actions. Questions may be directed to Lean White at (608) 267-0344.
- 3) ***Abolish*** the **Cereal Chemist–Entry** classification, ***retitle*** the **Cereal Chemist–Objective to Cereal Chemist** and ***modify*** the classification specification, **effective April 2, 2006**, to eliminate references to the entry level. DATCP plans to use only the objective level for future hires. There is no cost associated with this change and no positions need to be reallocated. - 4) ***Abolish*** the **Trust Funds Specialist 3** classification, ***retitle*** to **Trust Funds Specialist–Advanced**, and ***modify*** the specification, **effective April 2, 2006**, in order to reflect the change in job duties performed at both the objective and advanced levels. The affected agency will process reallocation notices for this action. Questions may be directed to Tammy Haack at (608) 266-8232.
- 5) ***Abolish*** the **Weatherization Technician 1** classification, ***retitle*** the **Weatherization Technician 2 to Weatherization Technician** and ***modify*** the classification specification, **effective April 2, 2006**, to eliminate references to the 1 level. The Department of Commerce plans to use only the objective level for future hires. There is no cost associated with this change. Positions currently classified as Weatherization Technician 2 need to be reallocated to the new Weatherization Technician classification under ER 3.01 (a) “A change in the concept of the class or series.” Questions may be directed to Lean White at (608) 267-0344.
- 6) ***Modify*** the **Revenue Field Auditor** classification specification, **effective April 2, 2006**, to move an allocation from the Revenue Field Auditor 7 level to the Revenue Field Auditor 8 level. The affected agency will process reallocation notices for this action. Questions may be directed to Tammy Haack at (608) 266-8232.

- 7) **Modify** the **Technical Writer and Technical Writer–Senior** classification specification, **effective April 2, 2006**, to remove the specific divisions listed and to allow for the use of classification in other divisions with special programs located in the Department of Health & Family Services and Department of Workforce Development. 
