
**Subject:** Implementation of the Consumer Protection Investigator 1, 2, 3; Consumer Specialist 1, 2, 3, 4; Apprenticeship Training Representative (A, B, C); Employment and Training Counselor (A, B, C); Employment and Training Specialist (A, B); Labor Market Analyst (A, B, C) and the Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor (A, B) Personnel Management Surveys.

Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the following classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is June 16, 2013**, unless otherwise stated.

- 1) *Abolish* the **Consumer Protection Investigator 1, 2, 3** and the **Consumer Specialist 1, 2, 3, 4** classifications and *Create* the **Consumer Protection Investigator** classification series as a result of the Consumer Specialist and Consumer Protection Investigator Personnel Management Surveys which accomplished the simplification of the classification system for these occupational areas. Reallocations will be processed by DOA Central Payroll. Agencies will process all necessary reallocation notices. - 2) *Abolish* the **Apprenticeship Training Representative (A, B, C), Employment and Training Counselor (A, B, C), Employment and Training Specialist (A, B), Labor Market Analyst (A, B, C)** and the **Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor (A, B)** classification series for the Department of Workforce Development as a result of the Personnel Management Surveys eliminating the lettered progression. No reallocation notices are necessary to accomplish this classification action. Questions can be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
- 3) *Create* the **Apprenticeship Training Representative, Employment and Training Counselor, Employment and Training Specialist, Labor Market Analyst** and the **Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor** classification specifications for the Department of Workforce Development as a result of the Personnel Management Surveys to update the duties and eliminate the lettered progression. Reallocations will be processed by DOA Central Payroll. Agencies will process all necessary reallocation notices. Questions can be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
- 4) *Create* the **Motor Carrier Investigator** classification series for the Department of Transportation, Division of State Patrol, Bureau of Transportation Safety, as a result of the Consumer Protection Investigator Personnel Management Classification Survey. This action removes the DOT positions from the Consumer Protection Investigator classification series to better describe the function of the DOT positions. Reallocation will be processed by DOA Central Payroll. The affected agency will process any necessary reallocation notices. Questions can be directed to Dianna McNall at (608) 266-8232.
- 5) *Reassign Pay Range* for the **State Patrol Trooper and Inspector** classifications from 36-40 to 63-40. The affected agency will process the reallocation notices. Questions can be directed to Paul Ostrowski at (608) 267-0343.
- 6) *Reassign Pay Range* for the **Vocational Rehabilitation Counselor In-Training** classification from 12-06 to 12-07. The affected agency will process the reallocation notices. Questions can be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
