- Current State employees can search and apply for jobs from the <u>STAR Human Resources</u> Employee Self Service (ESS) Homepage. Click on the Careers tile to begin.
- You will use the same credentials you use to access STAR Employee Self Service (ESS). You should not create a separate Wisc.Jobs login account.
- Job aids for the new system will be available on the DPM website.
- Applicants can still access their Job Cart in the legacy Wisc. Jobs system for information about jobs applied to before April 10, 2021 here: https://wiscjobslegacy.wi.gov/public/login.asp.

Wisc.Jobs, the official website for Wisconsin State Government employment, has been redesigned with a modern look and improved functionality! State agencies will begin posting positions to the public on April 12, 2021.

Please note, you will need to create a profile in the new system in order to apply for positions (except current state employees), so please plan on visiting the new site (<u>same address</u>) on or after April 12 to create a profile, search for jobs, and sign up for job alerts. If you have recently applied for a job, you will have access to your Job Cart in the legacy system until July 1, 2021. A link to the legacy Job Cart will be on the new Wisc.Jobs website, or you can click <u>here</u>. This will allow you to view your existing job applications, application statuses, and access your uploaded documents for jobs applied to before April 10, 2021. After July 1, 2021 the legacy system will no longer be available to the public.

Current State employees who use STAR Human Resources Employee Self Service (ESS) Homepage:

As of April 12, 2021, employees of the State will access job opportunities by logging into STAR Employee Self Service (ESS) and clicking on the Careers tile. As a state employee, you do not have to create a separate Wisc.Jobs account – you will just access job openings through STAR Employee Self Service (ESS). Job aids for current state employees will be available.
