To help keep state employees safe and healthy, the Department of Administration and Department of Health Services are holding free COVID-19 vaccinations at select state agencies.

Who is eligible?

All state employees, their families, and the general public ages 12 and older.

Do I need to register?

No. Walk-ins are welcome!

Why should I get vaccinated?
