Subject:   Military Leave for Annual Training



Article 13/10 of the WSEU Agreement provides that employes shall be provided paid leave for training. Such training duty must be for three (3) or more days in order for employes to qualify for the paid leave provision of the Agreement.

In order to qualify for paid leave, the qualifying requirement is based on the number of days ordered for training duty, not on the number of scheduled work days an employe is off work.

For example, if an employe is ordered to three (3) or more days of training duty but is scheduled to work only one (1) day during that period, the employe is eligible for one (1) day of military pay for the scheduled work day.
