The purpose of this bulletin is to assure a uniform and accurate means of calculating adjusted continuous service dates for reinstatements. Starting with transactions effective November 19, 2000, all agencies are instructed to use the computerized formula provided as an attachment to the electronic version of this bulletin (the website is http://der.state.wi.us/static/pdf/clrpol59.pdf) to calculate adjusted continuous service dates. Do not re-calculate any adjusted continuous service dates previously calculated using another method for personnel transactions effective before November 19, 2000. Use the computerized formula only for personnel actions effective on or after November 19, 2000.
