Subject: Limited Term Employee Appointment
Hours Related to Enactment of 2015
Wisconsin Act 58

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform appointing authorities of a change in the maximum hours allowed for a limited term employee (LTE) appointment. 2015 Wisconsin Act 58, effective July 22, 2015, has revised s. 230.26(1), Wis. Stats., to allow LTE appointments “for less than 1040 hours per year.” This Act is the result of a companion bill to the 2015-2017 Compensation Plan that was recommended to the Joint Committee on Employment Relations at a June 23, 2015 meeting.

Please note that s. ER 10.01, Wis. Adm. Code, still states that LTE appointments “shall not exceed 1043 hours of employment...” The amount indicated in the statutes will supersede the amount indicated in the Code until the Code can be revised.


