Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Administrator of the Division of Personnel Management (DPM) has approved the classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date May 15**, **2016**, unless otherwise stated.

- Abolish the Agricultural Marketing Consultant classification series for the Department of Agricultural, Trade and Consumer Protection as no future use of this classification series is planned and remaining duties have been collapsed and merged into the Agriculture Program Specialist classification series. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by the Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notifications will be completed by the affected agencies. Questions may be directed to Peter Flood at (608) 266-8149.
- 2) Abolish the Environmental Warden classification series for the Department of Natural Resources as no future use of this classification series is planned and remaining duties have been collapsed and merged into the Special Investigative Warden classification. There are no reallocations necessary for this classification action. Questions may be directed to Peter Flood at (608) 266-8149.
- 3) Modify the Agriculture Program Specialist classification series to create the Agriculture Program Specialist-Advanced level, update the specification's inclusions, exclusions, definitions and representative positions to reflect changes to the business area and to update add in language to cover positions formerly classified as Agricultural Marketing Consultants, which is abolished in this bulletin. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by the Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notifications will be completed by the affected agencies. - 4) Modify the Conservation Warden, <u>effective May 1, 2016</u>, for the Department of Natural Resources to provide general updates to the specification's administrative information and to update the definition language. *Reassign the pay range* from 05-40 to 05-63 as a result of the broadbanding of this classification. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by the Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notifications will be completed by the affected agencies. - 5) *Modify* the **Justice Program Supervisor** for the Department of Justice to update the definition language and representative positions. There are no reallocations necessary for this classification action. Questions may be directed to Dianna McNall at (608) 266-8232.
- 6) *Modify* the **Resident Care Technician** classification series for the Department of Health Services. The modification is to add an objective allocation at the Resident Care Technician-Entry level creating a multiple level classification series and update the progression language to define the movement through the series. - 7) Modify the Graphic Designer classification series to *abolish* the Graphic Designer-Entry classification level which is no longer used by State Agencies and update the definition language. *Reassign pay ranges* for Graphic Designer from 06-10 to 06-13 and Graphic Designer-Senior from 06-11 to 06-15. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notification will be completed by the affected agencies. - 8) *Modify* and *Retitle* the **Medigap Insurance Specialist-Lead** classification specification to **Aging and Long Term Care-Lead** for the Board of Aging and Long Term Care. The *modification* for this classification specification is to

add an allocation for a lead position in order to allow for a lead position that insures the provision of advocacy services to individuals residing in licensed and certified long term care facilities or who receive their home and community-based services through the Family Care/PACE/Partnership Programs or the Community Options Program. - 9) Modify the Safety Specialist Warden, <u>effective May 1, 2016</u>, for the Department of Natural Resources to provide general updates to the specification's administrative information and to update the definition language. Reassign the pay range from 05-41 to 05-63 as a result of the broadbanding of this classification. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by the Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notifications will be completed by the affected agencies. - 10) Modify the Special Investigative Warden, effective May 1, 2016, for the Department of Natural Resources to provide general updates to the specification's administrative information and to update the definition language as well as to modify the specification to allow for the inclusion of positions formerly classified as Environmental Warden. Reassign the pay range from 05-41 to 05-63 as a result of the broadbanding of this classification. Reallocations for this classification action will be processed by the Star Support Organization, but necessary forms and notifications will be completed by the affected agencies.
