Lodging in High-Cost Out-of-State Cities -

Effective February 1, 2022

The purpose of this bulletin is to notify agencies of a revision to bulletin DPM-0554-CC/TSA dated September 15, 2021. Specifically, the first sentence of the bulletin, which states "The approved Travel Schedule Amounts include provisions to establish lodging rates in excess of \$82 per night for certain out-of-state cities." only applies through January 31, 2022. Effective February 1, 2022, the approved Travel Schedule Amounts include provisions to establish lodging rates in excess of \$90 per night for certain out-of-state cities. This means that in situations in which the city, county or nearest comparable city is not listed, the maximum lodging rate will be \$90 per night.

This revision is made to reflect the February 1, 2022, increase to in-state rates in the 2021-2023 Compensation Plan.
