Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the classification plan changes identified on this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is April 3, 2005**, unless otherwise stated.

- 1) Abolish the Chemist Management Supervisor and Microbiologist Management Supervisor classifications, and create the Science Management Supervisor classification, effective
