Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the classification plan changes identified on this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the effective date is October 15, 2006, unless otherwise stated.

CHANGE IN CENSUS IDENTIFICATION CODES (CIC). The Division of Affirmative Action within the Office of State Employment Relations has concluded its review and analysis of the 2000 census. As a result of this review, all State of Wisconsin civil service titles on the Alphabetical Listing of Classifications have been updated to reflect these new census identification codes. - 1) Abolish the Aviation Manager classification, <u>effective October 15, 2006</u>, as this class is vacant and will not be used in the future. No reallocation notices are necessary for this action. Questions may be directed to Stephen Hermosillo at (608) 266-0714.
- 2) Abolish the Engineering Specialist Transportation Advanced 1 classification, effective October 15, 2006, as there are no filled positions within this class and it is not anticipated to be used in the future. - 3) Change in FLSA designation to the Aircraft Pilot classification, effective October 15, 2006, to indicate the classification as mixed (non-exempt as well as exempt). The change to mixed status correctly categorizes the State's pilots at DOA and DNR according to the courts and the new federal FLSA regulations. No reallocation notices are necessary for this action.
