In addition, the restriction of use by the Department of Agriculture, Trade & Consumer Protection (DATCP) was eliminated, allowing other agencies to use the class specification as appropriate. - 4) Modify the Revenue Customer Service Representative classification series specification, <u>effective February 15, 2009</u>, to update the organizational references to Customer Service and Education Bureau as a result of an earlier reorganization.
