Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the following classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is November 20, 2011**, unless otherwise stated.

- 1) Abolish the Board Steward, Gaming Veterinarian series, Presiding Board Steward Supervisor, and Racing Chief Steward classifications effective November 20, 2011, because the classifications are vacant and are not going to be used anymore. No reallocation notices are necessary to accomplish this classification action. Questions may be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
- 2) Create the Forensic Science Program Chief classifications <u>effective November 20, 2011</u>, as a result of the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory System reorganization which created a centralized crime lab management team. - 3) Modify the Environmental Enforcement Specialist classification series effective November 20, 2011, to update allocations for the Department of Natural Resources at the advanced level and to add allocations for the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection at the senior and advanced levels. The Department of Military Affairs was also included as an agency utilizing the classification. - 4) Modify the Payroll & Benefits Supervisor and Payroll & Benefits Program Supervisor classification specifications effective November 6, 2011, to allow positions that supervise the staff in a distinct payroll and benefits functional area within a large employing unit in the University of Wisconsin System to be identified within the P&B Program Supervisor specification. - 5) Modify the Waste Management Specialist classification series <u>effective November 20, 2011</u>, for the Department of Natural Resources to recognize advanced level positions that function as a department expert for a significant segment of the Waste Management/Remediation and Redevelopment Program with dedicated project management duties and specific program management expertise. The affected agencies will process any necessary reallocation notices to accomplish this classification action. Questions may be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
- 6) Modify the Food Safety Inspector series and Food Safety Supervisor classifications <u>effective November 20, 2011</u>, due to changes in the qualifications as required by the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection-Division of Food Safety. - 7) Modify the Real Estate Specialist classification series effective November 20, 2011 to update the functional areas and definitions within the series for the Department of Transportation, Department of Natural Resources, Department of Veterans Affairs, Department of Military Affairs and UW- Madison.
