Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is January 13, 2013**, unless otherwise stated.

- 1) Abolish the Food Safety Inspector classification series and Create the Food & Dairy Sanitarian classification series for the Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection as a result of the Food Safety Inspector Personnel Management Survey. - 5) Change the EEO code for the Revenue Field Agent 5 classification for the Department of Revenue to better identify the placement of the classification for Affirmative Action purposes by changing the EEO code category from protective services to professional.
