Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the following classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the effective date is October 7, 2012 unless otherwise stated.

- 1) Abolish the Police Officer Confidential classification specification for the Department of Administration. Due to the increase in the use of electronic communication methods, employees are no longer in regular contact with confidential information. Modify the Police Officer classification specification to include positions assigned to perform patrol and law enforcement work for the Governor, the Governor's Office, executive residence and other designated persons. The agency will process all necessary reallocation notices. Ouestions may be directed to Chelsea Daley at (608) 267-5165
- 2) Modify Corrections Services Supervisor classification specification for the Department of Corrections. This modification is to remove the references to specific allocations. No reallocation notices are necessary to accomplish this classification action. Questions may be directed to Pat Waterman at (608) 266-8149.
- 3) Modify the Crime Laboratory Director classification specification for the Department of Justice. This modification will reflect changes to the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory system to the WCL Bureau and to update the duties identified. - 4) Modify the Forensic Science Program Chief classification specification for the Department of Justice to reflect changes of the Wisconsin Crime Laboratory System to the WCL Bureau and to add an allocation for the Deputy Crime Lab Bureau Director.
