Pursuant to s. 230.09, Wis. Stats., the Director of the Office of State Employment Relations (OSER) has approved the following classification plan changes identified in this bulletin. Regardless of the actual notification date, the **effective date is November 3, 2013,** unless otherwise stated.

- 1) Create the Uuclaimed Property Representative classification series effective October 20, 2013 for the Department of Revenue to describe positions which perform paraprofessional work that requires specialized knowledge of the unclaimed program administered by the DOR.
