DENTAL CONSULTANT-LTE

I. **DEFINITION**

This is professional work of a consultative or technical nature performed by a licensed dentist. Positions in this class perform a variety of activities in the field of dentistry. The work may involve providing consultative and advisory services or providing dental services to the population of an institution or to a particular segment of that population.

Examples of work performed:

- Provide dental services and treatment during the absence of the institution dentist.
- Provide professional consultation service in a specialty area of dentistry.
- Perform as a research consultant in the area of dentistry, involving the design, implementation and evaluation of research projects.

II. QUALIFICATIONS

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

- Thorough knowledge of the methods, principles, practices, materials and equipment used in dentistry.
- Skill in performing all processes in dentistry.
- Ability to diagnose and treat diseases of the mouth.
- Ability to perform oral surgery as necessary.
- Ability to function effectively in a particular program or as a consultant based on demonstrated expertise in the pertinent area of dental specialization.

Training and Experience

Graduation from an accredited school of dentistry and professional experience relevant to the function to be performed.

Special Requirement

Possession of or eligibility for a valid license to practice dentistry in the State of Wisconsin.

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
